- ➤ To obtain lessons from the disaster and recovery process, applicable to JICA's future assistance for disaster risk management (DRM).
- Three (3) kinds of gaps were emerged between anticipated risk and actual risk, or capacity of society/community.
- JICA's "Trinity Approach" was proposed: (1) Risk Literacy, (2) Redundancy, and (3) KAIZEN, on the foundation of an integrated risk reduction strategy.
